All at St Patrick's wish you and your families a Happy Easter. May the risen Lord bless and keep safe in his love over the Easter break.

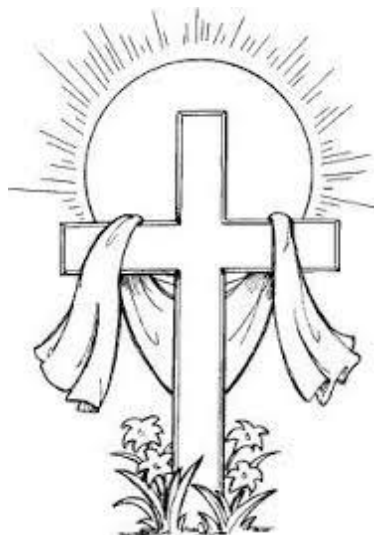

Girls Winter Uniform:

Light blue long sleeved blouse, royal blue tunic, royal blue tie, School jumper, Navy tights with black school shoes or plain white ankle sock with black school shoes. Hair must be tied back if past collar length, with **blue, gold or white hair ties**.
