WINTER UNIFORM – TERM 2 and 3

Girls Winter Uniform:

Light blue long sleeved blouse, royal blue tunic, royal blue tie, School jumper, Navy tights with black school shoes or plain white ankle sock with black school shoes. Hair must be tied back if past collar length, with **blue, gold or white hair ties**.

Boys Winter Uniform:

Long sleeved crested grey shirt, grey melange trousers, royal blue tie, school jumper, grey school socks with royal blue and gold trim, black school shoes. Hair must be tied back if past collar length, with blue, gold or white hair ties.

PLEASE NOTE No Jewellery (signet rings, chains etc.) / Friendship bands, necklaces / ankle chains etc. are permitted at school. If children have pierced ears, only small studs or sleepers are to be worn. Hair past collar length **MUST** be tied back (boys and girls). Blue, white or gold hair ties only, are to be worn. Nail polish is **NOT** permitted.


