**PARISH PRAYER: Please refer to the overhead screen****17th July 2022 - SIXTEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME YEAR C****First Reading: Book of Genesis 18:1-10**

The Lord appeared to Abraham at the Oak of Mamre while he was sitting by the entrance of the tent during the hottest part of the day. He looked up, and there he saw three men standing near him. As soon as he saw them he ran from the entrance of the tent to meet them, and bowed to the ground. 'My lord,' he said 'I beg you, if I find favour with you, kindly do not pass your servant by. A little water shall be brought; you shall wash your feet and lie down under the tree. Let me fetch a little bread and you shall refresh yourselves before going further. That is why you have come in your servant's direction.' They replied, 'Do as you say.' Abraham hastened to the tent to find Sarah.' 'Hurry,' he said 'knead three bushels of flour and make loaves.' Then running to the cattle Abraham took a fine and tender calf and gave it to the servant, who hurried to prepare it. Then taking cream, milk and the calf he had prepared, he laid all before them, and they ate while he remained standing near them under the tree. 'Where is your wife Sarah?' they asked him. 'She is in the tent' he replied. Then his guest said, 'I shall visit you again next year without fail, and your wife will then have a son.'

***A message from our St Patrick's Parish Finance Committee regarding the Planned Giving Program:***

The Planned Giving Program is our **main source of income** to satisfactorily continue to provide our share of the support of our priest, support our Liturgical program, meet our responsibility to the Diocese, cover all costs such as Insurance, Electricity and maintenance of the Church and Parish House.

The approximate cost of running our Parish is \$60,000 p.a. Kojonup parish provides approximately \$20,000 p.a. to assist with the support of our priest. Since July 2019 we have had to further make provision to be able to provide Long Service Leave to our priest when that falls due.

There are **two ways** to be part of this program – a weekly envelope, or an electronic transfer on a regular basis. Regrettably there are only about 12 families/individuals using the envelopes – providing approximately \$7000 and 10 families/individuals using the electronic transfer providing \$14,000. The first and second collections also supplement the planned giving program, totalling approximately \$18,000 for the year.

All Parishioners are welcome to join with your fellow parishioners and be part of the Planned Giving Program. Please Contact a member of the Finance Committee or the Parish Council and you will be assisted in becoming part of this vital Program.
